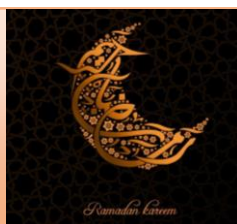

We are scientists. The children shared their science learning with each other and with their families for Great Science Share Open Afternoon.

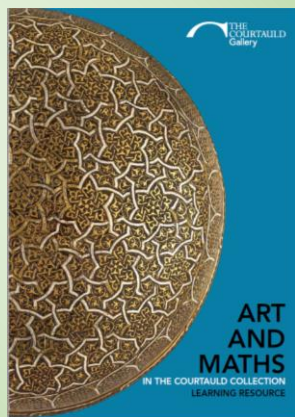
