Project: War is Coming

Knowledge

- An information poster about 'The 1940s home'. Include: sitting room, kitchen, baths and toilets, blackout time, cleaning, children's toys, entertainment.
- A public information leaflet explaining how people can keep safe during the blitz.. Include: air raids, gas masks, lighting restrictions (blackout) , identity labels, emergency rations

Understanding

- Explain how life was different in London during the war. Display as a poster or write an information leaflet.
- Write a diary entry that shows understanding of an evacuees worries and concerns.



Analysing

- How did the lives of wartime children differ to yours? Make a leaflet or poster to explain.
- Research the similarities and differences between German and British home front posters.

Create

- Make a model fighter plane.
- Create a food dish using a war time recipe
- Make a model of a 1940s home.



Apply

- Write a biography of either 'The Life of Anne Frank' or 'The Life of Winston Churchill'. Include: early life, family, likes and interests, why they are famous/ key achievements, death, how they inspired you.
- Write a short story set during the Second World War.

Evaluating

- Research and evaluate some inventions made during the war period.
- Research the effect the Blackout had on people's lives: what changes did they have to make to their day-to-living.
