Information for parents on our homework policy



Each child has a Home Learning Journal (a white reading log and homework book).

Inside the cover, you will find your child's logins for Mathletics, Oxford Owl, Languageut (French) and Google Classroom. This book must come to school each day in the child's PACT folder.



Homework is daily reading, and weekly spellings, number bonds and tables—

children are tested weekly for spellings and number bonds and tables.



Each child receives literacy homework

books—they are to be completed when the learning has been carried out in school—it is a practice tool.



Home learning project: half termly—this is compulsory, high quality expectations with a deadline for handing it in. All home learning projects are available on our website:

- There is a half termly home learning project. We expect the projects to be of a good standard.
- We set spellings and mad minutes weekly on Fridays- you will find them stuck in the white home reader book. Children are expected to practice daily and will be tested on the following Friday.
- In the Home Learning Journal, you will find a list of Oxford Owl books for the children to go through and a full breakdown of the weekly home learning the children are expected to cover. Children must read at least 20 minutes every day and write in the home reader books which pages they have read and any information you think we may need to know. Our reading prompt leaflets will help you to support your child's daily reading.
- Children should use the Mathletics programme to further develop the skills they have learnt in class. Children write this in their white reading log and homework book.
