You **MUST** complete the creative project designing a survival tool or gadget for Nick Carter-our resident explorer. Then choose at least two more from the other sections. Useful links can be found in your google classroom, your work can also be submitted there.

COMPULSORY PROJECT - Everyone must do this one!

Create

- Invent a tool or gadget that Nick Carter could use on his next survival trip later this year. You can make the gadget, design it on paper or make a computer presentation about it and submit it in our google classroom.

Knowledge

- Find out about places that have been flooded recently—write an informative report about places that have been flooded.
- Write a list of things humans need to survive and explain their purpose.
- **Black History Month: Write a biography/Create a project around a famous Black Briton.**



Analysing

- Make a mind map detailing situations where you might need different survival techniques.
- Look at different pictures of water and create your own, adapting some ideas from you've observed.

Understanding

- Make a menu to keep a person healthy for a week.
- Create a piece of poetry (with movement) about being in a flood.

Apply

- You are on a desert island. List the 10 items you would take and explain why that would help you survive.
- Make a leaflet showing how to be safe when near water or building a fire.

Evaluating

- Find a song about survival. Then answer this question: What instruments would you use to accompany it and why?
- Research organisations that help people who are victims of flooding—write about whether you think they are effective at doing this.
